# Udayan

#### Aims and Objects :

To impart lessons in the technique of dance and educate young people in the different aspects of performing arts. The courses in teaching the UDAY SHANKAR form is based on improvisation, composition and rhythm, production, lighting design, stage-craft, make-up, in different phases.

Uday Shankar always sought simplicity, power and beauty in his dances, which had an universal appeal.

"Udayan", while following the footsteps of Uday Shankar aims to produce not only good dancers but also good human beings inculcating in them the values of life and an aesthetic mind, who would be capable of spreading the universal language of love and friendship through the Uday Shankar form of dance and choreography.

#### Brief outline of the different Courses :

- A) **Beginners Group 'A'** : 4 years course (Boys and girls minimum 5 years of age) : basic exercises in the Uday Shankar form. Simple choreographic compositions and primary Uday Shankar form dance movement. Assessment made at the end of each session for promotion to next year's class. Annual reports given to students for appraisal of their guardians. At the end of the fourth consecutive year, (on successful completion of Beginners course) the students are eligible to join the Junior Second Year. (B 2nd year)

**Boys will have a separate section.**

- B) **Junior Group 'B'** : 4 Years Course (Boys and girls minimum 10 years of age) : Advanced grade exercise, choreography and dance movements of the Uday Shankar form. Assessment made at the end of each session for promotion to next year's class. Annual reports given to students to appraise their guardians. At the end of the fourth consecutive year, (on successful completion of Junior course) the students are eligible to join Senior Second Year (C 2nd Year)

**Boys will have a separate section.**

- C) **Senior Group 'C'** : 4 Years course (Girls minimum 14 years of age) basic exercises in the Uday Shankar form. Simple choreographic compositions and Uday Shankar form dance movements. Advanced grade exercises and Choreography, dance movements in the Uday Shankar form. Assessments made in all subjects at the end of each session for promotion to next year's class. Annual reports given to students reflecting their achievements as well as overall proficiency.

- D) **Boys Group 'D'** : 4 years course (minimum 14 years and onwards) basic exercise in the Uday Shankar form. Simple choreographic compositions and Uday Shankar form dance movements. Advanced grade exercise and Choreography, dance movements in the Uday Shankar form. Assessments made in all subjects at the end of each session for promotion to next year's class. Annual reports given to students reflecting their achievements as well as overall proficiency.

- E) **Advance Group 'E'** : (3 years course) Students for this course will be selected by the institution on the basis of their aptitude and proficiency in the final year of the senior course (Group 'C' & 'D'). This course deals mainly with costume designing, stage-craft, thematic choreography, music appreciation, imparting lessons to junior students, lighting design etc.

#### Certificate :

After satisfactory completion of the **Advance Course**, students are awarded a Graduation Certificate in either of the four categories Gold, Silver, Bronze or Ordinary, according to merit. However, on completion of a particular course (A/B/C/D) a general certificate of completion may be taken from the office on application, by the student concerned, within 3 months of such completion.

**Under no circumstances any certificate shall be issued to students, who have not completed the stipulated course in full, in a particular Group.**

Students having exceptional talent as a dancer and also having overall competence are given the option of joining our professional troupe as a regular member only after completion of the full course.

**Students shall attend classes as per routine given at the beginning of the session.**
